NORDIC GI CONFERENCE 2007

The annual Nordic GI Conference is this year organized in cooperation with Geoforum Denmark. Venue for the conference is Herning, Denmark. Dates are from October 1st to October 3rd., 2007.

The Programme Committee has identified the following topics, which will be prioritised at the conference:

- GI development within environment, health, infrastructure, civil emergency and research
- National GI-strategies in the Nordic countries
- Expectations to the ongoing INSPIRE implementation in the Nordic countries
- Web based GI (Second Life, Microsoft, Google...)
- Societal needs for geographic information (GI)
- National and international GI standards
- The role of GI in a globalised world

GI Norden and Geoforum Denmark expect, that the conference as a whole reflects the GI development within the following approaches:

- The political
- The technical
- The practical (usage)
- The educational.

THE CONFERENCE LAYOUT

Duration of the conference is three days. The first and the second day will begin with common keynote sessions. The rest of all three days will consist of three parallel sessions – of which one is devoted to GI Norden.

The conference will be bilingual. Danish will be the primary language at the conference, but at least one session line – the Nordic - will be in English.

In addition to the sessions there will be an exhibition, where important GI-businesses will present themselves and their products.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

The Nordic GI Conference 2007 will take place in Herning Congress Centre from Monday October the 1st to Wednesday October the 3rd 2007.

Participation in the conference will cost approximately DKK 6.200 including full service and 2 nights accommodation. Participants presenting a paper will receive a discount of DKK 1.800.

ABSTRACTS

All interested contributors are invited to submit their inputs as abstracts. All submissions must be sent to the secretariat of Geoforum Denmark by e-mail to: geoforum@geoforum.dk by April 12th, 2007. Please use the topic Abstract 2007 when submitting an abstract. Submission instructions are found on the Geoforum Denmark's website, where you also can download a Word template for preparing the abstract. Good quality abstracts will be accepted for oral presentations at the conference.

The length of the abstract must be between 250 and 500 words. Please specify the topic for the abstract and assign the abstract to one of the following approaches: political, technical, practical or educational.

Acceptance notification will be sent before June 1st, 2007.

After acceptance of the abstract, the author must allow Geoforum to publish part of or the entire presentation with strict and clear name of source.

Only the first author will be mentioned in the programme. With more than one author, the additional authors will be mentioned together with abstract in the conference catalogue.

The duration of each presentation will be 20 minutes for the parallel sessions.
