SOME BACKGROUND

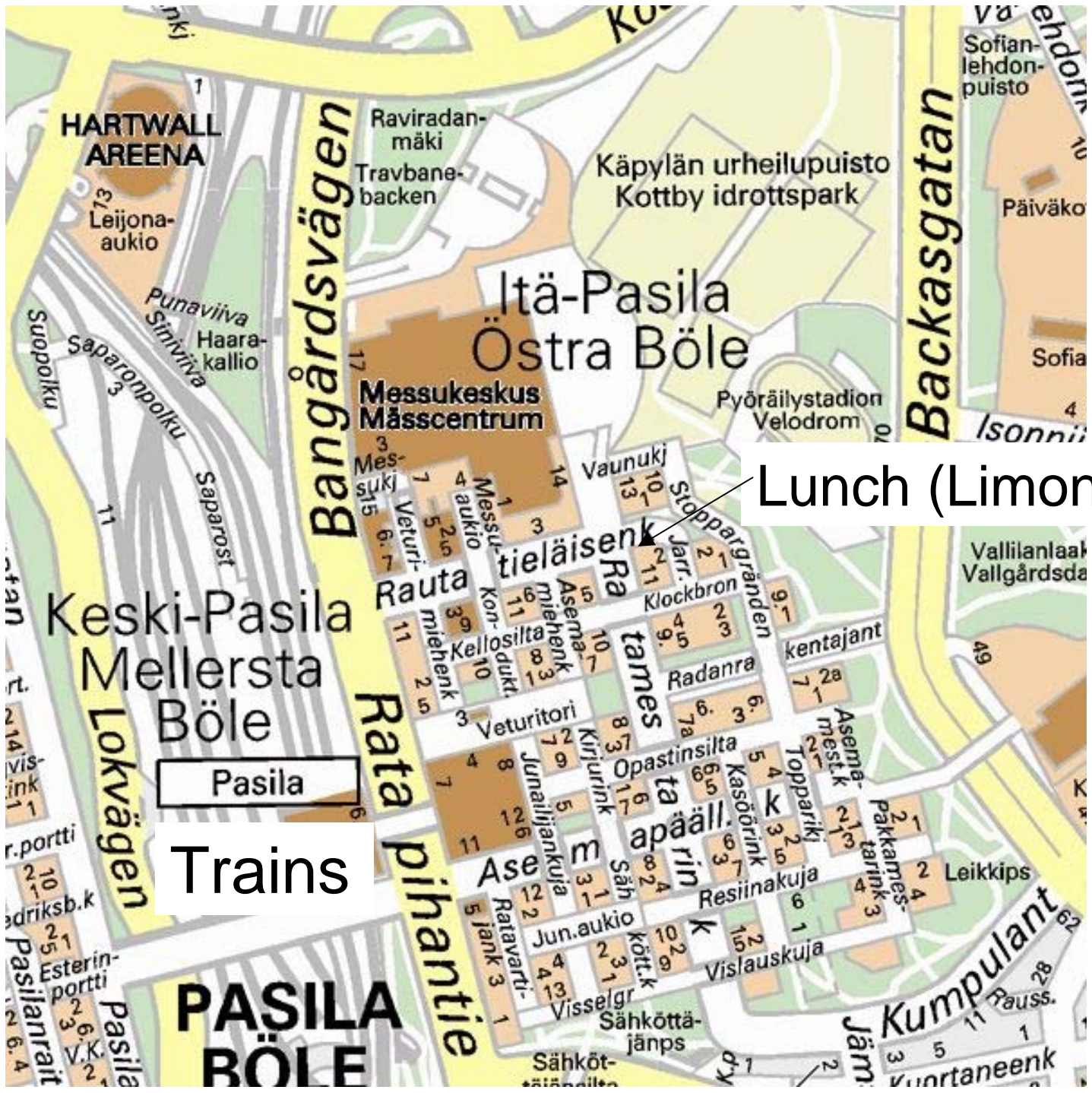
- inofficial, but regular co-operation in standardisation between the Nordic countries for several years
